The F-22 Raptor, like all maturing military aircraft programs, will undergo a series of retrofit and

modernization programs to resolve potential shortfalls and extend airframe life beyond its original design. These depot-based aircraft modification campaigns must be efficient enough to maintain and preserve military capability.

This presentation chronicles the maturation and implementation of Laser Shock Peening on F-22 primary structure to reduce risk of cracking and pave the way for airframe life extension. The Boeing Company teamed with Metal Improvement Company to mature this remote site capability and coordinated with the F-22 Team to implement it in a manner which reduces flow time by 50%. LSP treatment design and test program results will be covered. In addition, information on the process, equipment, and logistic adaptations necessary to merge state-of-the-art LSP processes with the practicalities of a real world fleet modification program are discussed.
